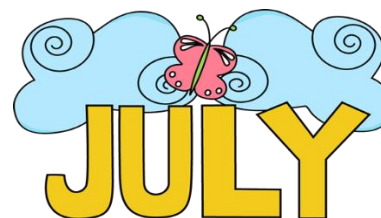


Monthly Homework:

FYI:

Word List: Your child has been assigned a Word List based on his/her individual need. There are 12 word lists (and all can be found on our class website!) and you’ll find more information about them in the letter in your child’s folder. A good habit to start would be to check it nightly, and by that, I don’t mean that all 50 words should be gone over every night. Start with 5 and once your child is confident with those 5, then move on. 😊 This isn’t a race, but a process in action. 😊 Please leave the word list in your child’s folder so that it will not be lost. Student Accounts: In our classroom, the children will be working on three online accounts: SpellingCity.com (to coordinate with our Letterland spelling/phonics program), Raz-Kids.com (reading) and Xtramath.org (math fast fact fluency which we will use a little later in the year). All are programs that can be accessed at home online for free, as well, but do not feel pressured to use them all nightly at home – the children use them in the classroom for practice, but if you would like to try them out at home, your child’s account information is taped to the inside of your child’s Homework Folder. 😊
